## INDEPENDENT STUDY

If you know that your child is going to be missing school for five days or more, it is essential that you sign up your child to do independent study while away. By doing this, your child stays current on their academics, absences are excused, and the school receives daily funding (approximately \$65 per day) from the state. Please be aware that it is critical that your child complete all of the work assigned in order to get credit for the independent study. There is no half credit as the auditors require work samples from every subject assigned. Therefore, incomplete independent studies will result in unexcused missing assignments, unexcused absences that will automatically start the School Attendance Review Board process, and a loss of revenue for the school district.
