HEALTHY SANDWICH IDEAS

- Egg salad sandwich on whole grain bread
- Peanut butter sandwich with 100% fruit spread (for a different twist, wrap it in a tortilla)
- Lean sliced deli meat with light mayonnaise, mustard, and a slice of cheese tucked inside pita bread.
