SCHOOL LUNCH APPLICATIONS

Please help Chicago Park School District receive the maximum state funding possible. The method of funding education for students in California drastically has changed under the California Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). To ensure Chicago Park School District receives the maximum funding available, we are required to collect data on household income. If you haven't done so already, we are asking ALL families to please fill out the application for Free and Reduced-Price Meals that was sent home in the first day packet. (Copies are also available online at chicagoparkschool.org or in the school office.) Only one form per household is necessary. Please return the completed form to the office as soon as possible, but no later than September 30th. The information you provide on the application will be kept in the strictest confidence and will ONLY be used for the purposes of determining the level of state funding to which the District is entitled to receive. Though we are required to inform you if you qualify for Free or Reduced-Price meals, it will be your choice to participate in that opportunity or not. Your individual personal information will not be shared with any agency or organization.
