I am so excited that you are here! Here is a little bit about me. If you have any other questions, please ask and I would love to share!

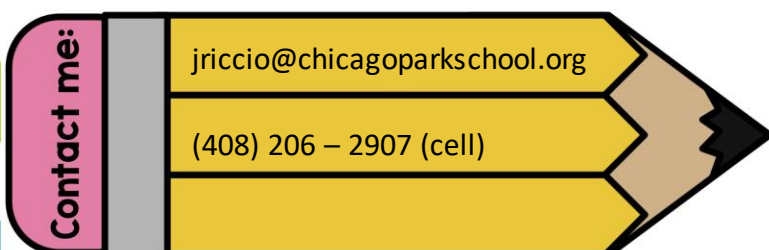
### **About Me**
