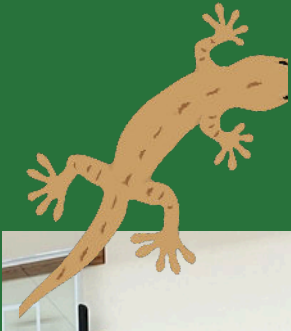

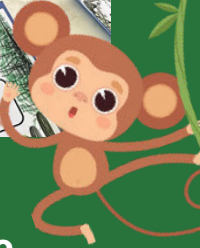
Wild Things Assembly
