Possible Approval of Resolution 2425-1** Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Chicago Park Elementary School District Ordering an Election to Authorize the Issuance of General Obligation Bonds, Establishing Specifications of the Election Order, and Requesting Consolidation with Other Elections Occurring on November 5, 2024.

Background

The District has important school facility improvement needs and wishes to identify a funding source. November 5, 2024, is the date of the statewide general election, and an election date at which local bond measures that provide facilities funding can be placed on the ballot. In order to appear on the November 2024 ballot, a Resolution calling a bond election must be filed with the Nevada County Registrar of Voters by August 9, 2024.

The Resolution for Board consideration has been prepared in accordance with all legal requirements and presents a \$1,500,000 bond measure to District voters under Proposition 39 for the purpose of financing projects summarized on the specific project list attached as Appendix A to the Resolution, which will be printed in the sample ballot provided to District voters. Appendix B includes the abbreviated statement of the measure and is limited to 75 words or less that will be printed on the ballot label and read by voters at the time of casting their vote. Appendix C presents the Tax Rate Statement which will also be printed in the Sample Ballot and discloses to District voters the current expectations regarding the property tax rates and other matters that will apply if bonds are approved and issued.

In order to call the election, the Resolution must have a 2/3 vote of the Board.
